Notice to Shareholders of the Calgary Danish Canadian Club: Extraordinary Meeting

The board is hereby giving notice of an extraordinary shareholder meeting where we will be able vote on a motion that will provide financial security via a cultural donation to the Danish Canadian National Museum (DCNM).

The extraordinary meeting will be held on the 4th of March 2026, at 19:00 in the Main Hall at the Austrian Calgary Cultural Centre, 3112 11th Street NE, Calgary, T2E 7J1

The board will provide an overview presentation outlining the development of a working plan to provide financial security to the DCNM through structured donations.

This Cultural donation will be available to support the DCNM with their new building project and the renovation project of their dormitories. This plan will begin in 2027 and support them well into 2030 . These monies will be guaranteed, held and managed by the DCC and dispersed as the project reaches approvals of other grants and funding. This Cultural investment and donation will allow all members to enjoy many years of our Danish Heritage well into the future.
