Jens Munk: An expedition ahead of its time

The Danish Canadian Club is hosting a speaker's forum that will present the attempt by Jens Munk 400 years ago to find the "North West Passage." He may have got stuck in Hudson Bay (Churchill River) through the Canadian Winter, but he came closer to finding the Northwest Passage than anyone had before (a full two hundred years before Franklin and 300 years before Amundsen).



The evening will start with dinner, followed by the presentation by Carl Sørensen from Edmonton, member of the board for the Danish Canadian Museum in Dickson and on the Jens Munk Committee.

First, I would like to thank all of you for your support in my role as the newest president of the Danish Canadian Club. Thank you to John Steffensen for serving as president for the past five years, and for staying on to guide me through my first year.

The Danish Canadian Club held a Casino on September 20 and 21. The club is the beneficiary of a casino profit share through Alberta Gaming and Lottery Commission, the amount of which will be announced





Peter's 25th Anniversary

On October 18, the Danish Canadian Club's members, shareholders and staff celebrated the 25th anniversary of Peter Christensen's tenure as General Manager of the Danish Canadian Club.

The event was a sold out crowd of 160 attendees who were treated with a great meal, along with tributes and stories about Peter from various speakers.

Peter's wife, Helle, gave an excellent speech about Peter's dedication to the club, frequently working 16 – 18 hour days and the support from her, the family and friends.

The following is a brief history Peter's accomplishments as General Manager of the club during the past 25 years:

In 1994, the club was in financial trouble and at that time, the board also decided to hire a general manager with proven experience in the restaurant business to get the club back on a sustainable, profitable basis. The task was to pay off a \$600,000 mortgage, pay the bank loans, and the substantial amount of debentures and bring in the customers to rent the rooms and food catering services to use our large building for other events to supplement the use by members for their parties and social events.

Over the intervening years the bank loans were paid, the debentures were redeemed, the mortgage paid off and substantial renovations and repairs were made to the building and equipment. The general manager's salary, which had been paid with IOUs in those initial years, was also paid off.

The club's mortgage was paid off in 2007 and in the subsequent years to date, the club went through good economic times but also

many challenges with recessions, the 2014 flood and downturn in the Calgary economy.

Under Peter's stewardship, the club has been able to navigate through these periods of uncertainty and is arguably the largest "not for profit" cultural club in Canada.

In recognition of his contribution to the success of the club, Peter was presented with a custom made carving knife from Dennis Olsen and on behalf of the board, the current "Board Room" was renamed "Peter's Room."

We then draw a membership card out of a drum with all the member cards in it, and if we have a match with someone who put their toonie in that day the pot is won, if not the pot will keep building up till we have a match.
